Request For Quotes - Hydro blasting Barre Municipal Pool

The City of Barre is soliciting quotes for the hydro blasting of the interior of the Barre Municipal Pool. The purpose of this project is to remove all old paint from the walls and floor of the pool structure prior to the start of the Pool Rehabilitation Project. The structure was sandblasted in the spring of 2017, which removed several years' worth of paint from the structure. This project will be removing only one layer of paint hence the hydro blasting rather than sand blasting. The pool structure is approximately 7,500 square feet and ranges in depth from three feet to ten feet. The project will involve the complete blasting of the walls and floor of the pool interior and complete clean up and removal of all remnants and debris. The project must be completed by Friday, May 1 as the rehabilitation project is scheduled to begin on Monday, May 4, 2020.

A pre-bid site visit will be held on Monday, March 23 at 11:00 am at the pool located at 59 Parkside terrace. Quotes will be due on Friday, March 27 by 11:00 am and can be delivered to the City Manager's office located at 6 North Main Street. The selected vendor will be notified on Wednesday, April 1 and can commence work at any time after notification. All questions should be directed to Jeff Bergeron, Director of Buildings and Community Services who is also the Project Manager for the Pool Rehabilitation Project.
