Applicants will be required to attend a Council meeting for a brief interview with members of the Council to discuss their interest in the public body to which they applied. Council meetings occur every other Tuesday at 6:00 PM in-person at City Hall and via Zoom. A schedule of [upcoming Council meetings](#) can be located on the City's website.
