Definition

The qualified applicant will carry out the daily operations of the swimming pool. Above all the have enthusiasm for making the pool a safe and fun place for the community. Requires the ability to interact positively as an effective member of a working team

Examples of Duties

- Oversee the operations of the pool facility and programming under the direction of the Assistant Director of Buildings and Community Services – Recreation.
- Maintain a daily log of all events, activities and incidents that occur.
- Supervise all pool staff in the performance of their duties and enforce all rules and regulations.
- Must ensure the safety of all swimmers
- Responsible for surveying the entire pool and pool areas
- Enforce all pool rules and keep other pool staff alert of potential hazardous situations
- Assist in maintaining the cleanliness and quality of the pool and pool area
- Consult with the Department Head regarding issues with any important equipment required for the safe and effective execution of the position
- Oversee the swimming lessons

Minimum Qualifications

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must possess good leadership and decision making skills
- Must work well with other
- Must have a positive attitude with both staff and patrons
- Must be a certified life guard or be able to be a certified lifeguard.
