- Misty set up a fundraising Paint Nite at the Quarry Restaurant to be held on Sunday, August 5 at 2pm
- Ideas to get the word out included posting on the Barre City Dog Park (which has been done) and on Front Porch Forum both the Barre Town and Barre City editions and to post every few days so people have a chance to read about it
- Discussion about having a Grand Opening BBQ when the shelter is complete and having a donations jar to help with fundraising
- Having a photographer present for the Grand Opening of the shelter at the Park to take pictures was suggested. Also, posting those pictures on Facebook using the #BetterBarre
- Wish list of items for the Park to fundraise for include agility-type structures and a granite sign to mark the entrance of the Park
  - Suggestion for the granite sign was to contact the Barre Granite Museum and see if they had any large scrap granite that they would be willing to donate or give us a reduced price on
  - Nick to get Jeff the contact information for the business that engraved the granite name plates for the City Council
  - We will be posting a poll on the Barre City Dog Park Facebook page with a wish list of items to put fundraising dollars towards

Suggestion was made to check with the Granite Museum and see if they have any large scrap piece of granite they would be willing to donate or sell for a reduced cost. Nick will get Jeff the contact information for the company that did the granite engraving for the City Council
- A clean up of the overgrown areas leading to the park entrance was suggested. City has told Jeff that they will help with leveling the path to the park to make it safer
- The picnic table on the small dog side needs to be removed/replaced. Jeff will remove it.

#### 3. Parvo

O Discussion about a puppy at the Cause for Paws event that was later found to have Parvo. Puppy did not go into the Barre Town Dog Park so risk of infection is low
