

SPECIAL BARRE CITY ENERGY COMMITTEE MEETING

Monday, January 25, 2021 at 5:30 pm

1. **Call to Order:** 5:34 p.m. on the video conference platform ZOOM.
2. **Adjustments to the Agenda:** The agenda would be adjusted to accommodate for giving B. Long time to join us.
3. **Visitors and Communications** (*for something not on the agenda*): None.
4. **Old Business:**
 - a. **Approval of Minutes of the Special Energy Committee Meeting January 6, 2021:**
A motion was made by P. Cecchini and seconded by R. Palmer to approve the minutes, motion carried unanimously.
 - b. **Community Engagement Report Update (EcoStrategies):** D. Sachs gave an update on the survey she has been compiling. Afterward, discussion about the prizes that needed to be chosen - 4 winners have been chosen, and the Committee needed to decide who and how to get the certificates to them. The two phases of the survey were discussed, and P. Cecchini stated he felt that each of the surveys were the same. P. Cecchini made a motion to award the gift cards to the first and second winners from the pooled, or non-segmented group of survey respondents; C. Teal seconded, and **motion carried unanimously.**

The first name drawn using a random number generator will be contacted as the winner and be given the choice of the gift card to the MeltDown Restaurant, or \$50 in cash. The second person drawn would then receive the alternate prize from the first winner's choosing.

J. Shatney asked about the ETA of the survey, an D. Sachs said she was wrapping it up, and will absolutely be ready for next month's meeting. She is also working on the framework that we've asked for as well and will have that ready.
 - c. **Update from Efficiency Vermont.** B. Long gave his status of where EVT is, where he is on his schedule with us and his other customers. Talk led to the EV stations in the city, how much they are being used, etc. J. Shatney shared the City Clerk's memo for City Council that week that showed usage, and cost. B. Long suggested that perhaps zoning could be changed to add language that requires any new development be required to install

56 the tenants, and how to engage with the landlords? J. Shatney will get the information
57 onto the city webpage as soon as it is provided.

61 3:00 pm, and need to coordinate with and make an interview. D. Sachs said she still
62 wants to move forward with “Be Like Fred” as well.
