Possibly Icy New Year's Day



OVERVIEW:

- On New Year's Day, precipitation is expected to transition from snow, then to sleet and/or freezing rain, and then rain.
- Transition of precipitation type likely late in the day into the overnight hours.
- Please continue to monitor this situation for additional details.

TIMING

- Light snow will be possible in the afternoon.
- A mix of sleet/freezing rain is more likely late New Year's Day and into the overnight hours. The transition to rain takes place early Saturday morning.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

Slick travel is the most likely impact.

FORECAST CHALLENGES

It is a complex forecast pattern, but stronger than usual signals for potential ice accumulations are present.
