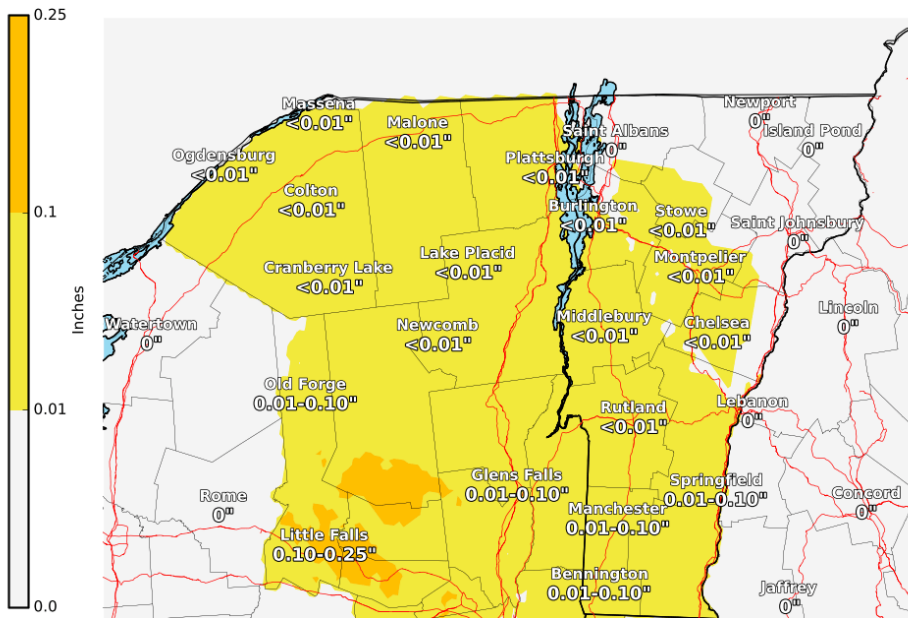
WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- A period of snow, becoming a wintry mix, and then rain still appears likely.
- The timing of precipitation has been slowed, meaning most of the wintry mix is expected Friday night, but could lead to slick roads early Saturday morning.
- Please continue to monitor the situation for additional details.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Snow is expected to begin late New Year's Day (After 7 PM). ▪ A transition to a wintry mix likely after midnight, then becoming rain mid-morning on Saturday. ▪ Snowfall amounts of 1"-3" possible. ▪ Ice accumulations generally less than 0.10" possible.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Slick roads will be possible early Saturday morning. ▪ Impacts to utilities appear limited.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The latest data suggests a shorter window of a wintry mix, but the signals for snow and light ice accumulations remains largely unchanged.
NEXT BRIEFING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ By 5 AM Thursday – December 31st.
