

# Winter Storm to Impact the Area



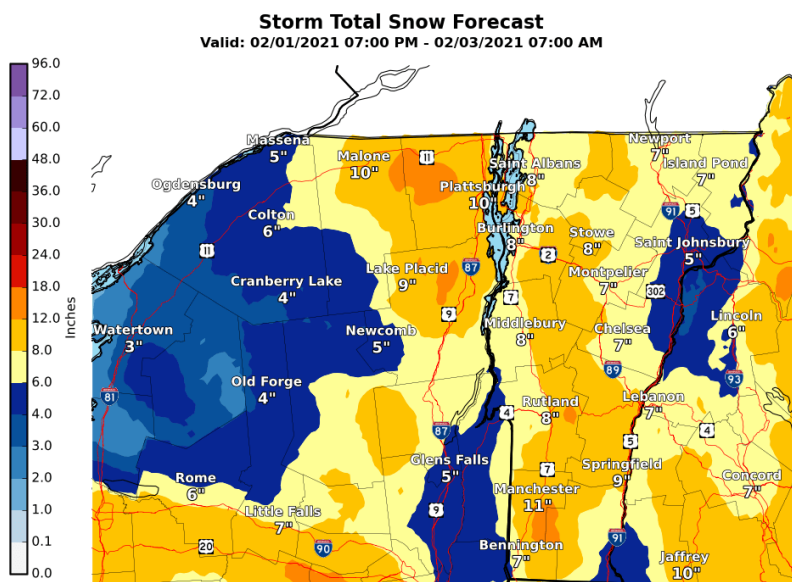

## OVERVIEW:

- No changes to headlines and alerts have been made at this time.
- Greatest amounts expected over the eastern portions of the northern Adirondacks and southern Vermont where 8 to 13 inches will fall, while the remainder of the area sees 4 to 8 inches with localized higher amounts.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Onset Monday evening thru Monday night, spreading from south to north.</li> <li>▪ Steady snow tapers off from south to north on Tuesday.</li> <li>▪ Tuesday night through Wednesday sees more terrain-driven snow.</li> </ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The Tuesday morning commute will be difficult, with more localized impacts Tuesday afternoon and Wednesday morning.</li> <li>▪ Limited utility impact with snow tending to be on the fluffier side.</li> </ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ A Winter Storm Warning is in effect from 12 PM Monday to 7 PM Tuesday for Bennington and Windham Counties in Vermont.</li> <li>▪ A Winter Storm Warning is in effect from 4 PM Monday to 7 AM Wednesday for western Clinton County and western Essex County in New York and eastern Rutland and Windsor Counties in Vermont.</li> <li>▪ A Winter Weather Advisory is in effect from 4 PM Monday to 7 AM Wednesday elsewhere, except for southwestern Saint Lawrence County.</li> </ul>
