### Snow/Ice Friday Night into Saturday



#### **OVERVIEW:**

- A period of snow, becoming a wintry mix, and then rain still appears likely.
- The timing of precipitation has been slowed, meaning most of the wintry mix is expected Friday night, but could lead to slick roads early Saturday morning.
- Please continue to monitor the situation for additional details.

# TIMING

- Snow is expected to begin late New Year's Day (After 7 PM).
- A transition to a wintry mix likely after midnight, then becoming rain midmorning on Saturday.
- Snowfall amounts of 1"-3" possible.
- Ice accumulations generally less than 0.10" possible.

## HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Slick roads will be possible early Saturday morning.
- Impacts to utilities appear limited.


### FORECAST CHALLENGES

■ The latest data suggests a shorter window of a wintry mix, but the signals for snow and light ice accumulations remains largely unchanged.
