How the hunt works: At approximately 9:45 a.m. we will start sending individuals to their appropriate hunt areas.

The hunt is broken down into age groups:

3 & 4 Years 5 – 7 Years 8 – 10 Years

3 & 4 year olds. A group leader will call this age group and direct everyone to the hunt area.

Parents may go into the hunt area with this age group but we ask that you let the children

pick up the eggs. **Please note the contents of the eggs are not recommended for children under the age of 3.**

5 /6/7 year olds. A group leader will call this age group and direct everyone to the hunt area area. **Parents will need to wait outside the hunt area.**

8/9/10 year olds. A group leader will call this age group and direct everyone to the hunt area. **Parents will need to wait outside the hunt area.**

At **10:00 a.m.** you will hear a very loud police siren. When you hear the siren, the hunt begins.

Parental guidance is recommended with regards to if your child can eat the piece of candy that they have received from the hunt. Candy and toys are not recommended for children under 3 years of age.

RECYCLE: We welcome an opportunity to recycle the plastic eggs for next season. Anyone wishing to recycle the eggs can drop them off weekdays at the Barre City Recreation Department which is located on the back side, ground level of Alumni Hall, adjacent to the Barre Auditorium.
